FREN0500-S02: I think that there was a concerted effort in the French 500 curriculum to teach the language through a variety of mediums and techniques. I think that the use of the French Film Festival as a resource for learning in particular was very effective. Language is intertwined with culture and an understanding of the places and people that use it. While the class didn't stress a perfect french, it truly accomplished meeting this message.
FREN0500-S02: Materials included 2 novels (both contemporary), a graphic novel, and several films. The graphic novel was applicable to the unit on the French school system but was a little bizarre... I would suggest another graphic novel such as Persepolis which is more well known and can stimulate more interesting discussion. There could be fewer movies and perhaps some shorter television programs instead. Overall, I enjoyed the materials and how they introduced conversational French, but at least one work of literature would have been beneficial.

FREN0500-S02: Daily grammar exercises, readings, films, daily class and group discussion

FREN0500-S02: I would have liked to see more coverage of other francophone nations and their cultures outside of metropolitan France such as Morocco, Quebec, Belgium, etc. Monsieur Ibrahim was a great unit that touched on different world religions and there could be more materials like this. Conversation sections weren't as useful as I would like them to be. Pairing each student with a native French speaker would be ideal, although I recognize the difficulty of this.
